











Community Conection Center






Light has been recognized as the main and influential element in the project, and the façades and structure of the project have been designed accordingly. On the southern side, we have a fully glass façade to allow better light for the central courtyard. Similarly, the interior spaces are positioned on both sides of the project based on their lighting needs. The project's façade is designed according to the required light levels, providing varying intensities of light throughout different times of the day




ISLAMIC ART MUSIAM
